School

Calvary Chapel Academy is a private Christian school enrolling 125 students from grades Pre-K through 12th Grade. This year there are currently 35 students in grades 9 through 12. The school opened in the fall of 2003 and this spring will graduate the first senior class. Calvary Chapel Academy is currently a member of ACSI, the Association of Christian Schools International.

Curriculum

The academic program at the high school level is organized in a rotating schedule. Students take seven, 42 minute classes during the day with specialized teachers in of the various academic classes. Students have the option of taking College Prep or Honors classes.

AP® classes are offered in US History, Calculus AB, and Literature and Composition. The Advanced Placement program is an open-enrollment program.

Honors classes are offered in English, Physical Science, Biology, Chemistry, Physics, Geometry, and Trigonometry and Pre Calculus.
